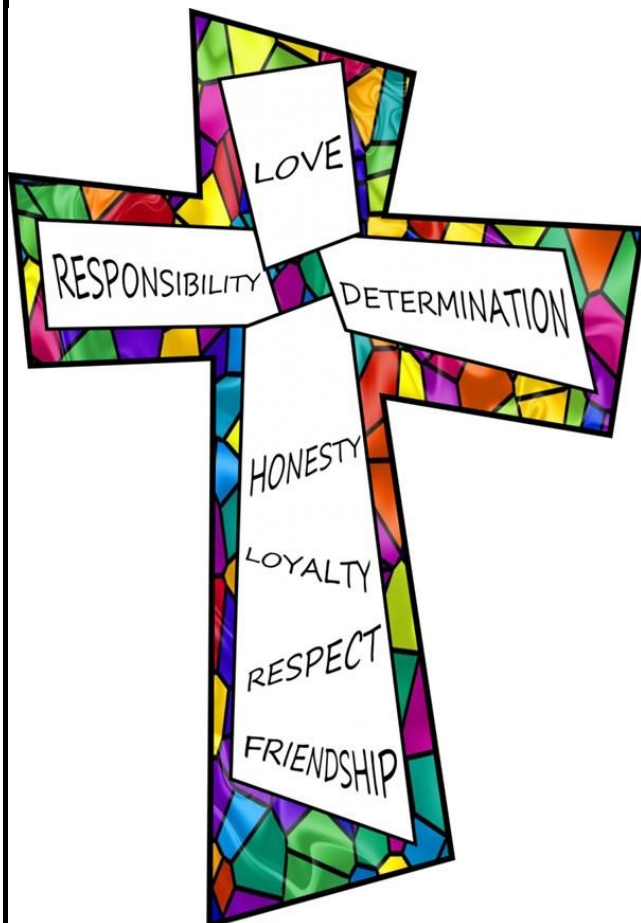

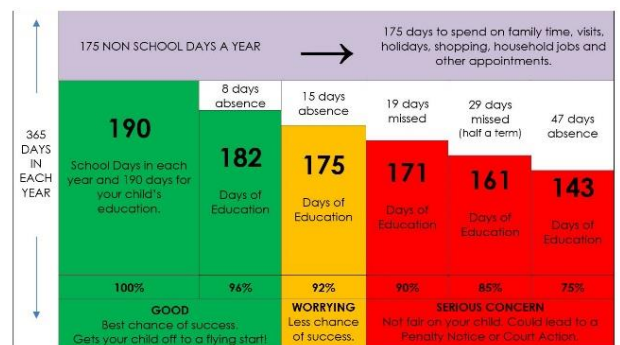

TASA Composite Relay organised by WLSP



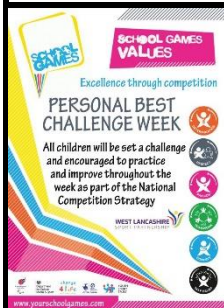
