


## World Book Day 2024



# Sow, Grow and Farm

Year 5 enjoyed a visit from Mr James Buck, who is a retired farmer. The children found out how farming has changed in the local area. Farming started in the local area as small holdings where people grew what they needed to survive on small pieces of land and perhaps they also had a few chickens and cows. This developed into large farms, especially with the building of coastal defence embankments which were built in the 19<sup>th</sup>

century. Year 5 found out that the local land is flat, and its fertile soil is ideal for growing crops such as wheat and vegetables. The children also discussed how farming



machinery has changed. Mr James Buck also brought in seeds for year 5 to plant – cauliflower, peas, beetroot, and beans. Year 5 are very grateful to Mr James Buck for such a lovely visit. We look forward to seeing how our




