





In **Reception**, we have enjoyed sharing and talking about our favourite books and characters.

We have listened to stories being read to us, read stories to others and acted out stories through role play.









Year 1 have been sharing their love of reading on World Book Day! We've spent time reading our favourite books for pleasure, and all presented our favourite book to the class, explaining why it is our favourite. We also watched a video celebrating World Book Day, spotting lots of authors that we know and love.

We are currently studying traditional tales in English and these four girls came in that theme!









The children in **Year 2** have thoroughly enjoyed their World Book Day today! They loved: showcasing their outfits in front of all their friends, discussing their favourite books with the class and sharing a story with some Year 6 children. They were even authors when writing their stories in English!



In **Year 3**, we have been talking about the characters we have dressed as today. We have been listening to stories from our teacher and we have been looking at the World Book Day website https://www.worldbookday.com/ which has all sorts of information about reading and the FREE book that we can get with our £1 book token.







Year 4 have been exploring the key features of children's book covers and how they can entice us to read the story inside. We have designed our own book cover today for a story we are writing in English. We have some exciting story plans already written, ready to write in full tomorrow. Year 5 enjoyed World book day, we continued to create our stories based on the book - Hugo Cabret. The children also enjoyed talking about the characters they dressed up as.

We could certainly count on them to support their friends!





What a fantastic home learning project for the children of Hesketh-with-Becconsall All Saints as the school of this very special parish! Thank you for your continuing support of our school and the local community.


