

The Dogs Trust started in 1891 as a small group which vowed to campaign against cruelty. Now they are one of the UK's leading dog welfare charities.

### Dogs Trust work

- Dogs trust cared for 12,546 dogs through our 22 centres across the UK and Ireland. 9,707 of these dogs were rehomed, including 463 that had been with us for more than six months.
- Dogs trust donated 19,500 dog meals to Fareshare and opened food banks at 10 rehoming centres to help dog-owning families through the cost of living crisis.
- With the help of our committed foster carers, we fostered 3,822 dogs through our Home From Home and Freedom programmes, and rehomed 2,697 of those.


