



Music Curriculum Statement of Intent, Implementation and Impact

At All Saints we aim to enable our children to use the universal language of music within a high quality musical education that promotes the love of music and use of talent in a variety of contexts.

All children are taught to sing by the subject leader who is a music specialist from Reception to Year 6. Children are taught to use the language of music in context (called the Elements of Music) and have opportunities to appraise and listen to a wide range of music across several genres. Children also have opportunities to learn musical instruments including violin, piano, drums and guitar with experienced and enthusiastic tutors.

Children at All Saints love to sing and create music, and in doing so gain musical skills that they can apply through further education and into adulthood. We love to sing and perform to a high standard at regular venues throughout the school year including Infant Nativities, Junior Carol Concerts, Christmas singing for the turning on of the Christmas lights, singing at the Christmas Fair, the Spring Concert at HBCC, the Arts Festival at Tarleton Academy and in our biannual whole school productions.
