Writing in Reception

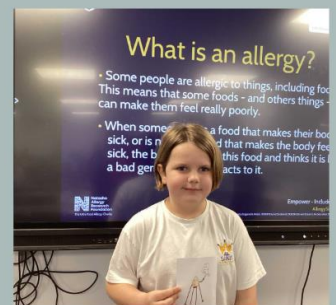

Writing in Reception

Within Continuous Provision the children have been labelling a farm some of the boys built, actively using their phonics knowledge to apply words for their labels. We have also had writing in our new Grocery shop, labelling pieces of fruit and veg ready to sell to our customers and the children have also been busy writing in RE about people and things they love! What a fabulous first day back Reception enjoyed!

In PSHE, Year 4 have started Allergy School. Allergy School resources help teachers and children to understand and feel empowered about food allergies. The class found out which were the 14 top food allergens, as about 1 in every 12 children experience food allergens. The children thought about how a person with food allergies might feel in different situations. Year 4 created Feelings creatures to illustrate this. Allergy School has been developed by Coram Life Education our PSHE provider.

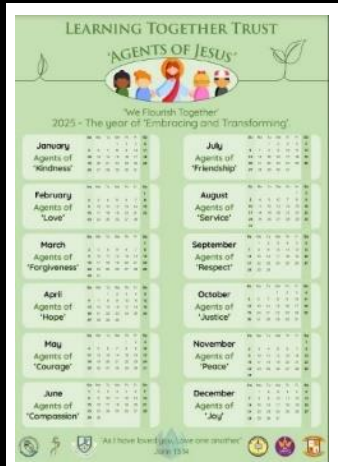
