Jude for working hard in all areas of his learning including when we painted landscapes, he could tell me all about his jungle.

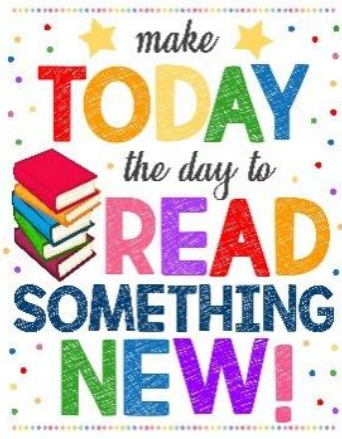
**Year 1:** Lexi and Isabelle for beautiful presentation and handwriting.
